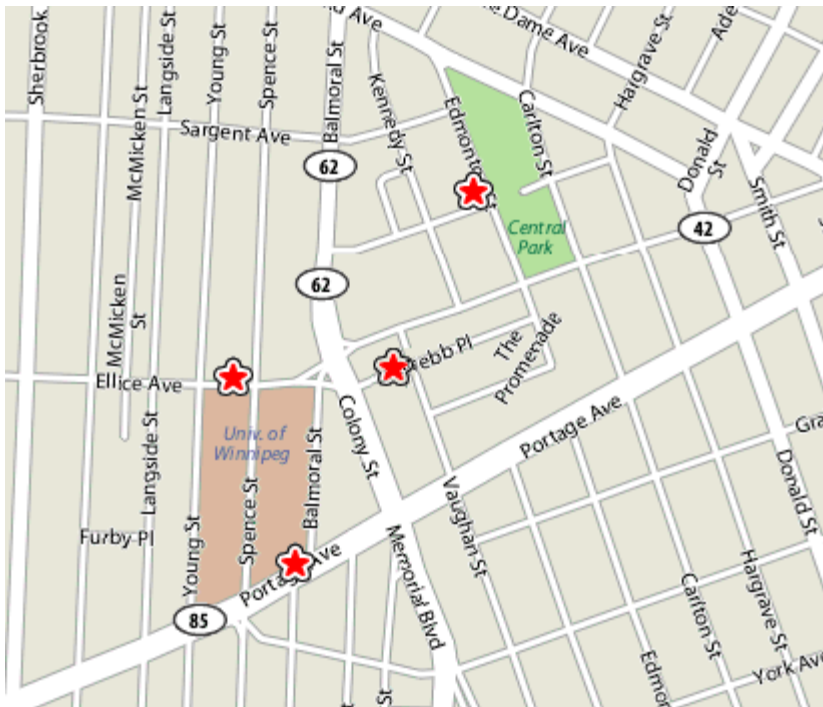

The International Centre offers family programs in four different locations where they can make the greatest impact on our community.

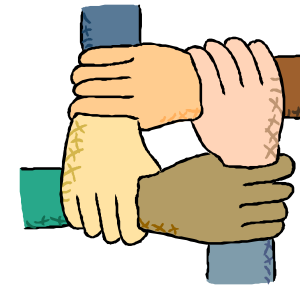
