
## Access English Centre Immigrant Centre Manitoba COMMUNITY, GETTING AROUND: A Lovely Day "Fill-in the Blanks" Work-out Activity 60 minutes Multi-level

Instruct the participants to take some time to look at the worksheet. <i>Think</i> and decide which word could fit in the blank. After filling in all the blanks, the participants can continue the story. Think of another 5-10 more sentences. The sentences may be written down on the sheet.</li> <li>4. They will read their stories together.</li> <li>5. Afterwards, each <i>pair</i> will choose one person to <i>share</i> their stories with the whole</li> </ul>							
	group (whole class). Variation Activity #1: For beginners, use the beginner sheet that has pictures beneath the blanks. Variation Activity #2: For intermediate, use the intermediate sheet with its suggested							
	word list. Participants can use the words or create their own suitable words to fill in the blanks.							

	Continue the story: think of another 10-15 more sentences. The sentences may be written down on the sheet and told orally to the whole group.
Variation Activity #3	For advanced level, have the participants complete the story using their own words. Continue the story; think of another 10-15 more sentences. The sentences may be written down on the sheet and told orally to the whole group.
