## Access English Centre Immigrant Centre Manitoba CULTURE & CITIZENSHIP: - "Award Interviews" Work-out-"The AEC's" ("The Oscars") Activity

## 60 minutes Intermediate/Advanced Level

<u>Facilitator Note</u>: This speaking activity is good practise with question formation. It provides meaningful interaction. This is a think-pair-share activity for the participants.

Work-ou	t:
<u>Material</u>	<u>s</u> : Participants need: pens/pencils Facilitator needs: whiteboard and whiteboard markers awards (pre-cut blank award papers) optional: certificate seal stickers
5 min.	<ul> <li><u>Procedure</u>: Introduction- Before you begin:</li> <li>1. Explain the activity. Write "The AEC Awards (Access English Centre Awards)" on the whiteboard. Also write "The Oscars" as a point of reference.</li> </ul>
10 min.	<ul> <li>Activity:</li> <li>Instruct the participants to come up with award ideas. Emphasize positive awards. Ex. "The Best Attendance", "The Most Improved", "The Most Active", "The Best Singer", etc.</li> <li>Give the participants a few minutes to <i>think</i> up of ideas.</li> <li>Write the participants' responses on the whiteboard.</li> <li>In <i>groups</i> of 3-4, participants choose 1 or 2 awards that they would like to give out. Participants will label their awards.</li> <li>Participants then decide what questions they should ask (at least 3) in order to determine who should receive the award.</li> <li>Ex. Did you miss any sessions? Were you late for your group? Did you participate actively with your group? Do you like to work together with your partners?</li> <li>Ex. Are you an expert in singing? Do enjoy singing?</li> </ul>

	Do people compliment you on your singing?			
25 min. 20 min.	<ol> <li>Give time for participants to come up with their questions.</li> <li>Groups take turns conducting interviews with each other.</li> <li>One group interviews all the members of the group next to them and then decides which person in the other group receives the award they are handing out.</li> <li>Each person must answer at least 3 questions before an award may be given.</li> <li>Continue until all groups have been interviewed and given an award.</li> <li>Groups can <i>share/present</i> awards to the "winners" with the whole class looking on.</li> <li>The winner could give a short "Thank You" speech after receiving the award.</li> <li>If needed the facilitator can model a thank-you speech.</li> </ol>
