| 10 min . | Point to the sentence starter and instruct the participants to use this sentence. Have everyone seated together in a circle-facing each other. Introduction: The facilita tor will expla in activity. |
|  | 1. Begin by saying, "Families like to go on vacations" <br> 2. The next participant on the left, says the sentence starter. Families like to go on picnicstogether. <br> 3. Everyone takestums sharing their ideas. |
|  | 4. Next, divide the whole group (whole class) into 2 teams. Give them 5 minutes to think-up of original ideas (ideas that were not shared as a whole group, before) together. <br> 5. Each team member will share their results. <br> 6. Optional: The facilitatorcan write their responses on the whiteboard. <br> 7. The facilitatorcan give a description of a family activity. The first person from a team that can guess it correctly wins a point forhis/ herteam. <br> Ex. Facilitator: This is a family activity where you go to see many different a nimals. <br> Kim rings the bell first. Kim: go to a zoo <br> Facilita tor: Right. Team A gets a point.
