Multi-level: Warm-up Activity
Look, See, View Game
15 minutes



Objective/Goal:

This is an observation activity of everyday items.
The participants help each other to label the items that they see/view.

Materials:

Participants need:

- worksheets,
- pencils/pens

Facilitator needs:

- Photo Cards (can bought at any teacher's supplies store or pictures cut from magazines, flyers, or actual digital photos of examples of a pen cap, paper clip, pencil, string, yarn, twig, eraser, toothpick, nail, tack, pen, etc.)
- Timer
- Optional: computer(with internet access)
- Optional: projector
- Optional: screen
- Optional-whiteboard & markers

Procedure:

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Introduction-

Before you begin:

1. **Pair** the participants:

Option #1: Instruct the participants to find a partner.

Option #2- Partner the participants by instructing them to get into two's.

Option #3- Give each participant a partner.

2. **Explain** the activity to the whole group. Demonstrate.

Optional: You can write their responses on the whiteboard.

Activity:

3. **Hand-out** 10 photo cards to each pair.

4. **Instruct** the learners to take some time to look at the photo card.

For Beginner Level: give them 10-12 minutes.

For Intermediate Level: 5-8 minutes

For Advanced Level: 5 minutes.



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5. Afterwards, the pairs are to **place** their photo cards face down.
6. The participants will **think** and decide what they saw in the photo card. The participants **name** the items/ objects that they see. If they like, they can **write** down their items on paper. The participants will **review** the list with each other.
5. Afterwards, each **pair** will choose one person to **share** their findings with the whole group.
6. The facilitator can **write** their findings on the whiteboard.

*Variation Activity #1: This activity can be played as a game. The pair with the most and correct number of items is the winner.

**Variation Activity #2: Instead of photo cards, items(your choice)can be displayed on a screen with the use of a projector of downloaded items from the computer.

****Variation Activity #3: A tray /containers of real items/objects can be used. One tray or container of the identical items can be given to each group.
