



**Pop Topics** 

# 90 minutes

## Objective/Goal:

Gives the opportunity for participants to think critically and share their thinking with their peers.

#### Materials:

### Participants need:

- Attachment #1 (Pop Topics)
- markers/pencils for each group

#### Facilitator needs:

- whiteboard
- whiteboard markers
- bell

Procedure: (Warm-up)
15 minutes

- 1) Write "Pop Topics" on the whiteboard.
- 2) **Gather** the participants together.
- 3) **Define** or go over "**Pop Topics**"- "*impromptu topics*".
- 4) **Ask** them if they can brainstorm/think of ideas about different situations.
- 5) The Facilitator will **give** an example.

### Ex.: Today's news.

- 6) **Demonstrate**. **Talk** about today's news for 2 minutes.
- 7) **Explain** to the participants that each participant will be given 2 minutes. They are to talk about the subject. Give each participant a topic card.
- 8) **Use** a timer and **give** each participant 2 minutes to speak about their topic card. (Attachment #1)

## 90 minutes

### Objective/Goal:

Gives an opportunity for participants to build problem-solving skills and share ideas with each other.

#### Materials:

Participants need:

- index cards

#### Facilitator needs:

- whiteboard
- whiteboard markers
- desk bell

Optional: For Extension Activity-computer

- projector
- screen

Procedure: (Work-out) 60 minutes

- 1) **Gather** the participants together facing the whiteboard.
- 2) **Explain** to the whole group that each person will be given an index card. Each person will write any appropriate topic. They will play a game using the "Pop topics" that they wrote on index cards.
- 3) **Brainstorm** possible starters together:(ex. Explain, tell, etc.). Write these words on the whiteboard.
- 4) Write a couple of examples: "Explain how to change a tire."

  "Tell us about your pet."
- 5) Have class discussion about "Pop topics".
- 6) Give each a participant an index card and a pen/pencil.
- 7) **Tell** the participants that they have 5 minutes to **write** 1 topic using any of the sentence starters.
- 8) First, tell them to write a number on the blank side of the index card.
- 9) Next, write a topic on the lined side of the index card.
- 10) **Gather** everyone's cards.

#### 90 minutes

- 11) Next, **shuffle** the cards. **Call out** the number on the index card and **give** the participant the card.
- 12) The participant then must **talk and share** about the "Pop topic" to the whole group.

### **Extension Activity:**

 An Extension activity is an alternative or extra activity that can be done to supplement an activity when you have extra time. It can also be done in the next class as a review of previous vocabulary or conversation.

90 minutes		
Objective/Goal:  Gives participants an opportunity to share their ideas with each other.		
Materials:	Facilitator needs:	
Participants need:	- container(ex. plastic basket)	
- index cards - markers		
Procedure: (Cool – Down) 15 minutes		
1) <b>Gather</b> the participants together.		
2) <b>Give</b> each participant a card.		
3) Participants will <b>write</b> their names on the cards.		
4) The facilitator will <b>collect</b> all the cards in a container.		
5) Each participant will <b>choose</b> a card. He or she will <b>call out</b> the name of the card and say a topic.		
6) The participant whose name is <b>called out</b> will them talk about the topic.		

7) Demonstrate: Jin **chooses** a card from the container. She **reads out** Hui's

Jin: Hui, do you prefer coffee or tea, and tell us why?
Hui: I prefer coffee because it is stronger than tea. I like the
aroma of coffee in the morning. I like it with cream and
2 lumps of sugar.
