



Spring Frolic

	90 minute

Objective/Goal:

Gives the opportunity for participants to learn common Spring vocabulary.

Materials:

Participants need:

- Spring flashcards (Total=24, Attachment #1)
- magnets

Facilitator needs:

- magnetic whiteboard
- whiteboard markers
- Attachment #2(Vocabulary List) for reference

Procedure: (Warm-up)
15 minutes

- 1) **Gather** the participants together.
- 2) Write: "Spring" on the whiteboard.
- 3) Brainstorm as many words associated with "Spring".
- 3)Optional: Write as many "Spring words" on the whiteboard.
- 4) **Introduce** 5-6 "Spring" vocabulary that the participants did not mention. Choose 5-6 Spring flashcards.
- 5) **Place** these flashcards on the whiteboard using the magnets.
- 6) Instruct the participants that they will play "charades".
- 7) **Explain** that each person will do actions or act out to show the "Spring" vocabulary. The participants will guess the word.
- 8) **Demonstrate**. The Facilitator acts out the 1st round.
- 9) Participants **act out** the 2nd round.





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Objective/Goal:

Gives an opportunity for participants to work on their observation skills when viewing various Spring scenes.

Materials:

Participants need:

- -pencils (enough per group)
- Optional:Attachment #3 (Extension Activity)

Facilitator needs:

- whiteboard and whiteboard markers
- computer(with internet access)
- projector
- screen
- timer
- Attachment #3
- Attachment #4

Procedure: (Work-out) 60 minutes

PART A:

- 1) **Have** the projector ready to display the website:

 http://freebigpictures.com/spring-pictures/
 -various assortment of Spring photos for demonstration-Choose beforehand appropriate picture.
- 2) On the whiteboard, write simple sentences:
 - I see
 - It looks like.....
- 3) **Instruct** participants that they will work in small groups. A Spring scene will be displayed on the screen.
- 4) Each small group will **view** the spring scene and work together to **describe** as many all words that they see in the picture.
- 5) One person is the "writer or scribe" and will **write** down his/her small groups' ideas.
- 6) **Demonstrate. Write** Spring vocabulary on the whiteboard. Ex. flowers, grass, sunshine, etc.





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- 7) For each picture, **give** the participants 10 minutes to discuss. Use timer.
- 8) Each small group will **share** their findings.
- 9) Move onto the next picture. Give another 10 minutes.
- 10) **Share** again with the whole group.
- 11) Last picture-give another 10 minutes.
- 12) **Share** the results.

PART B(25 minutes):

- 13) **Gather** all the participants together. Have them facing the screen.
- 14) **Instruct** the participants to listen to a story that you will be reading aloud to them. The participants will provide the missing words.
- 15) **Read** each sentence slowly and clearly and ask the participants to guess Spring vocabulary that would complete the sentence/story.
- 16) **Display** story on the screen.
- 17) Later **fill-in** the missing words or display Attachment #3.
- 18) **Share** results with the whole group. Compare the results with the answers from Attachment #4.
- 19) **Display** Attachment #4 on the screen.

Extension Activity:

A. For **Part B activity**, an alternative activity, keep the same small groups and **give** Attachment #3 to each small group. **Give** them 15 minutes to work together. Afterwards, **share** results. **Display**

Attachment #4 to review the answers.

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Objective/Goal:

Give participants a fun opportunity to review Spring vocabulary.

Materials:

Participants need:

- Optional: Attachment 5

- Optional: Attachment #6

Facilitator needs:

- whiteboard and whiteboard markers
- computer(with internet access)
- projector
- screen

Procedure: (Cool -Down) 15 minutes

- 1) **Have** the projector set-up on the following website: http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=_ZXdJ46IX0I
- Animated simple Spring song with words to sing along(karaoke feature) (2:34)
- 2) **Have** the participants sit facing the whiteboard.
- 3) **Instruct** the participants to listen to the song first.(1 st time)
- 4) The second time, **encourage** the participants to sing along (2 nd time).
- 5) **Sing** it 1 more time; you can **point** to the words (3 rd time).
- 6) This time **ask** the participants what are the "Spring words" in the song?
- 7) One final time (4^{th} time), **play** the song again but this time, the participants will clap their hands when they hear a "Spring" vocabulary.

Extension Activity:

*An extension activity is an alternative/extra activity that can be done to supplement the main activity, if there is extra time. The extension activity can also be done for the next class as a review of previous vocabulary or conversation.


