

Access English Centre Immigrant Centre Manitoba Intermediate Level: Warm-up Activity



Survivor Island

15 minutes

Objective/Goal: Gives participants the opportunity to be creative and work collaboratively together-"a sense of community"	
Materials:	Facilitator needs:
Participants need:	- whiteboard
- 4 or 5 pictures from a calendar ("island pictures")-1 per group	- whiteboard markers
Procedure:	
1) Brainstorm different "survival items" to whole group. Write their answers on the whiteboard: Ex. water, knife, rope, food, and clothing	
2) Explain to the participants that they need to figure out 5 more things important items or objects to survive.	
3) Discuss within their groups.	
4) Divide the whole group into smaller groups of 4 or 5.	
5) Give each small group an "island" picture.	
6) Have a small group discussion	
Extension Activity:	
* An extension activity is an alternative or extra activity that can be done to supplement the main activity, if there is extra time. It can also be done in the next class as a review of previous vocabulary or conversation.	
A. If there is some extra time, afterwards, have each small group present to the whole group.	

Questions can follow, afterwards from the whole group.

Choose 1 person to be the spokesperson for each group or have

each person say 1 item to the whole group.
