***COMMUNITY, GETTING AROUND: Icebreaker Activity***  
***“What Do you Like to Do? Survey” Warm-up Activity***  
**15 – 20 minutes**  
**High Beginner**

**Facilitator Note:** This warm-up activity is designed to be a fun activity for participants so that they may get to know each other by asking each other what are their common interests/hobbies. They will find out their dislikes and likes. It helps the participants to be more comfortable with one another.

**Warm-up:**

**Materials:** Participants need: What Do You Like to Do” Activity sheets, pencils/pens  
 Facilitator needs: Whiteboard and whiteboard markers

5 min.

**Procedure:**

*Before class:*

- 1) Write “Good morning” or “Good afternoon” on the whiteboard. Then the facilitator writes his/her name on the whiteboard. The Facilitator introduces himself or herself to the group.
- 2) Have the participants write their names on name cards (take a piece of paper and fold it (a heavier paper works best).
- 3) Hand out the “What Do You Like to Do” Activity sheets to each participant.

10-15 min.

*Introduce the Activity : ( 10 minutes)*

- 4) Brainstorm (Ask the group what are some things that they like to do.)  
*Write* their answers on the whiteboard:  
 Ex. dancing, singing, etc.
- 5) *Explain* the examples that they give are: “Hobbies” or “Interests”
- 6) *Write* the following 3 prompts on the whiteboard to explain the directions. **Student A: Do you like .....**?  
**Student B: Yes, I like.....**  
**Student C: No, I do not like.....**
- 7) *Explain* to the group that they are to interview each other. The goal is to find out what are your participants’ interests (hobbies).
- 8) Each participant will go and *ask* a classmate if he/she likes to do the following activities listed on the activity sheet.  
**Do you like .....**?

	<p>9) If their answer is a <b>"yes"</b>. The participant responds by saying, " <i>Yes, I like skating.</i>" Write his/her name on the line below the picture.</p> <p>10) If the participant responds by saying <b>"no"</b> - "No, I don't like skating." Then the student goes to the next person until he/she finds someone who likes the activity. Every line should have a different name.</p> <p>11) Demonstrate the activity.</p> <p>12) Go over the directions again. Read aloud together (with the group) the words.</p>
