# 90 minutes

### Objective/Goal:

Gives the opportunity for participants to learn common winter vocabulary.

#### Materials:

 Winter flashcards
 (Total= 32 Attachment #1 with accompanying vocabulary list)

- magnets

#### Facilitator needs:

- magnetic whiteboard
- whiteboard markers

Procedure: (Warm-up)
15 minutes

- 1) Gather the participants together.
- 2) Write: "Winter" on the whiteboard.
- 3) **Brainstorm** as many words associated with "Winter".
- 3)Optional: Write as many "Winter words" on the whiteboard.
- 4) **Introduce** 5-6 "Winter" vocabulary that the participants did not mention. Choose 5-6 Winter flashcards.
- 5) **Place** these flashcards on the whiteboard using the magnets.
- 6) Instruct the participants that they will play "charades".
- 7) Explain that each person will do actions or act out to show the "Winter" vocabulary. The participants will guess the word.
- 8) **Demonstrate**. The Facilitator acts out the 1st round.
- 9) Participants **act out** the 2<sup>nd</sup> round.

#### Objective/Goal:

Gives an opportunity for participants to work on their observation skills when viewing various winter scenes.

#### Materials:

Participants need:

- -pencils (enough per group)
- Optional:Attachment #2 (Extension Activity)

#### Facilitator needs:

- whiteboard and whiteboard markers
- computer(with internet access)
- projector and screen on:
  - http://www.bigfoto.com/themes/nature/winter/ #./?& suid=13637245887890507428050223429 or old calendar pictures of winter(enough for each group)
  - Timer
  - Attachment #2
  - Attachment #3

Procedure: (Work-out) 60 minutes

#### PART A:

- 1) **Have** the projector ready to display the website on the screen:
  - <a href="http://www.bigfoto.com/themes/nature/winter/#./?&\_suid=13637245887890507428050223429">http://www.bigfoto.com/themes/nature/winter/#./?&\_suid=13637245887890507428050223429</a> for demonstration
- 2) On the whiteboard, write simple sentences:
  - I see .....
  - It looks like.....
- 3) **Instruct** participants that they will work in small groups. A winter scene will be displayed on the screen.
- 4) Each small group will **view** the winter scene and work together to **describe** as many winter words that they see in the picture.
- 5) One person is the "writer or scribe" and will **write** down his/her small groups' ideas.
- 6) **Demonstrate. Write** winter vocabulary on the whiteboard.

- 7) For each picture, **give** the participants 10 minutes to discuss. Use timer.
- 8) Each small group will share their findings.
- 9) Move onto the next picture. Give another 10 minutes.
- 10) **Share** again with the whole group.
- 11) Last picture-give another 10 minutes.
- 12) **Share** the results.

#### PART B(25 minutes):

- 13) **Gather** all the participants together. Have them facing the screen.
- 14) **Instruct** the participants to listen to a story that you will be reading aloud to them. The participants will provide the missing words.
- 15) **Read** each sentence slowly and clearly and ask the participants to guess Winter vocabulary that would complete the sentence/story.
- 16) **Display** story on the screen.
- 17) Later **fill-in** the missing words or display Attachment #3.
- 18) **Share** results with the whole group.

### **Extension Activity:**

A. For **Part B activity**, an alternative activity, keep the same small groups and **give** Attachment #2 to each small group.

**Give** them 15 minutes to work together. Afterwards, **share** results. **Display** Attachment #3 to review the answers.

# Procedure: (Cool – down) 15 minutes

- Have the projector set-up on the following website and display on the screen: http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gFqkfJ\_ggA
- 2) **Have** the participants sit facing the whiteboard.
- 3) **Instruct** the participants to listen to the song first.(1 st time)
- 4) The second time, **encourage** the participants to sing along (2 nd time).
- 5) **Sing** it 1 more time, you can **point** to the words(3 rd time).
- 6) This time **ask** the participants what are the "Winter words" in the song?
- 7) One final time(4<sup>th</sup> time), **play** the song again but this time, the participants will **clap** their hands when they hear a "Winter" vocabulary word.
- If there is time, try the other song by Ronan Keating. Winter nature scenes are featured in this Youtube clip along with lyrics.

#### **Extension Activity:**

Notes: Both songs were chosen due to their slow tempo and easy vocabulary. (easy to clap and find words)


