Winter Safety # 2 & Vocabulary

Warm-Up and Work-out 60 minutes Beginner Level

Warm-up/Work-Out

<u>Materials</u>: Participants need: a set of pictures of winter clothes and a set of winter safety vocabulary cards

Facilitator needs: White board and white board marker, a set of pictures of winter clothes and a set of winter safety vocabulary cards.

Preparation needed: You will need one set of cut out words and pictures about winter clothes and safety vocabulary cards for each pair of students.

Procedure:

Warm-up activity:

Whole class Practice Drill #1: Have participants repeat the vocabulary and the sentences.
 Review winter clothes and safety vocabulary by holding up the pictures and words, and asking the whole group to repeat the pronunciation. "In winter, I need to wear a winter jacket." (10 min)

Workout activity:

- Whole class Practice Drill #2: Have participants say the correct sentence that matches the picture prompt. Hold up one of the cards; for example, "wear a winter coat". Ask the group: "What do you need to wear in winter?" so that they will reply "In winter, I need to wear a winter coat". Continue with the other cards. Alternate between asking the whole group, and individual students. (10 min)
- Model all of the partner activities before the students do the activities.
- Partner Practice Drill: Each participant gets a set of the words and pictures. Ask participants to work with their partners to practice the frame sentence "What do you need to wear in winter?"
 They then get a picture or word card from the pile and ask their partner to give the answer to the frame sentence "What do you ______?" (10 min)
- Fluency practice: Provide the following suggestions of frame sentences that they could use to ask their partner. "Do I need to...?" "How often do I need to...? "Review adverbs of frequency on the board "never, sometimes, usually, always". They can also use one of their own sentences to ask their partner about something that they want to know that is related to the topic. (E.g. "In your home country do you need to") (10 min)

Cool down activity:

- 1) Play the memory game with the whole group by saying one word and have the learners use the word in a sentence. Then the learners repeat the sentence out loud after the teacher. (10 min)
- 2) Encourage natural linking in the sentences ("whaddaya need to wear in")
